

2025 Maine UPMA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM RULES

Scholarships: One individual \$1000.00 scholarship to be awarded. The Maine Chapter of UPMA is proud to announce we will be carrying on our tradition of awarding scholarships.

This year there will be one scholarship awarded. It will be awarded to a graduating senior attending College, Vocational/Technical or Community college. The scholarship will be awarded upon completion of the first semester and the submission to the treasurer of Maine UPMA of the transcript and enrollment in the second semester.

Scholarship Committee

The Committee shall consist of four members, three from the education field and the fourth being an active UPMA member, who shall serve as its chairman. The chairman shall receive and coordinate all applications, make copies of pertinent information, and distribute same to all members of the Committee. At all meetings of the Committee, the chairman shall answer any questions and give explanations necessary but shall not participate in the selection process. After the winners are selected, the names shall be submitted to the chairman, who will notify the recipients and the unsuccessful candidates.

Criteria Recipients are to be selected based on academic achievement, leadership, school, and community participation.

Eligibility

You must be the child, stepchild, or grandchild of an active UPMA Member or Retired UPMA Member in good standing.

Requirements for Application***

1. College entrance exam scores
2. Grade point average
3. Copy of high school transcripts
4. Extracurricular activities
5. Work activities

Procedure Funding will come from the Maine UPMA Scholarship account. All proceeds in the scholarship account shall be audited annually and reported on at the general business session at the state convention.
